



Seven Habits Successful Church Consultants Develop in Their First Year

















Seven Habits Successful Church Consultants Develop in Their First Year



Habit #1 - They do two free or low-price consultations

- Experience is invaluable.
- Referrals are natural.
- Rookie mistakes are accepted.

Warning: Church consultation is not a get-rich-quick scheme.





Habit #2 - They ask for referrals

- This may be the differentiator between those who get clients and those who don't.
- Get feedback so you know what type of referral and recommendation you will get.





Habit #3 - They become students of local congregations

- They read Lyle Schaller, Thom Rainer, Sam Rainer, Chuck Lawless, Nelson Searcy, etc.
- They listen to podcasts on the local church: Rainer on Leadership; EST; Revitalize and Replant, etc.





Habit #3 - They become students of local congregations

- The gold mine called Church Answers.
- They are highly collaborative.





- Keep it simple.
- Keep it inexpensive.
- Keep it consistent.





Habit #5 - They develop a dynamic written template

- It is usually called "the deliverable."
- It is how you will be remembered, both short-term and long-term.
- Grammar and style are critically important.
- Don't hesitate to emulate.





- The number one mistake of church consultants.
- The number one pain point of church consultants.
- Answering that question incorrectly dooms the consultation.





Habit #7 - They stay pugnaciously persistent

- Most consultants keep all these action items going three years before they see significant fruit.
- Church consultation has a flywheel effect – but it takes time.
